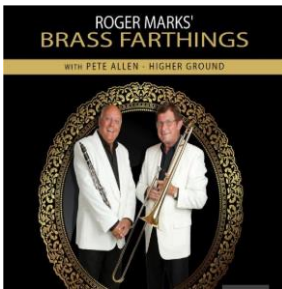


**NEW! The Incomparable HENRY RED ALLEN Volume 1**

Upbeat Jazz is proud to release the first volume in a new series of Red Allen's finest recordings from the 1930s. These classic sessions are now made available to collectors for the first time in recent years, showcasing Allen's unsurpassed trumpet and vocals on such timeless gems as *There's A House in Harlem For Sale*, *Believe It*, *Beloved*, *Rug Cutter Swing* and *Ain'tcha Got Music*. Many great instrumentalists are also featured including Coleman Hawkins, J.C. Higginbotham and Buster Bailey.



**NEW! ROGER MARKS' BRASS FARTHINGS featuring Pete Allen – Higher Ground**

This album is the latest from respected trombonist, Roger Marks. He has teamed up with Pete Allen and both their date sheets are really full. Both are active bandleaders in their own right and play both in the UK and Europe on a regular basis. This is the third album of Roger Marks on the Upbeat Jazz label following the critical acclaim of the first two - ROGER MARKS IN RETROSPECT – URCD270 and MARKS AND SPARKS – URCD278. Barry Clare wrote in *Just Jazz Magazine*: *Roger Marks, one of our foremost jazz musicians....an example of all that is good about British Jazz....*



**NEW! OTTILIE PATTERSON – The First Lady of British Blues**

**JASMCD2657 1 CD £12.99**

By far the most outstanding and powerful female British Blues/RnB singer of her era, former Belfast art teacher OTTILIE PATTERSON sang with Chris Barber's band between 1955-73. She recorded prolifically, both as a solo artist and as an ensemble band member, and this compilation is drawn from both sources. Includes a handful of solo singles, plus 7 sides from her critically-acclaimed 1961 solo LP, *Blues Book Vol.1*, and tracks from The Chris Barber Band's three biggest-selling albums, *In Concert, Vols 1, 2 and 3*. Features duets with Sister Rosetta Tharpe, Sonny Terry and Brownie McGhee and Louis Jordan. Otilie was an exceptional live performer, and 10 of these sides are either from official Live albums or gigs which Barber recorded professionally but never released. A half dozen of the tracks are virtually impossible to find elsewhere on CD.

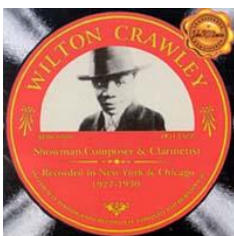
Here is a double album that represents the best of 'The Roaring Twenties'. It contains no fewer than the 48 biggest hits of the final two years before the world plunged into the Great Depression: music of happy hedonism can be enjoyed with each track performed by the original artists including 20 number 1 hits like *Sonny Boy* in 1928 & *Tiptoe Through The Tulips*, *Ramona* and *The Wedding Of The Painted Doll*. Artists include Paul Whiteman, Fred Waring, Nat Shilkret, Ruth Etting, Gene Austin, Helen Kane, Rudy Vallée and Cliff Edwards.



**NEW! Decidedly CHARLIE SHAVERS - His 46 Finest 1937-1960**

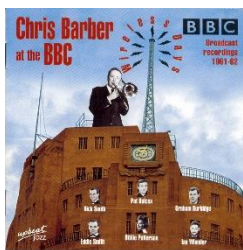
**RTS4340 2 CDs £14.99**

The 46 tracks here display the sheer range of his abilities. His earliest, often muted, playing with the bands of such as Jimmie Noone, Johnny Dodds and his breakthrough with John Kirby's sextet at a surprisingly young age including his classic *Undecided*. He then spent years with Tommy Dorsey's Orchestra including the famous *Jazz At The Philharmonic* concerts. From the mid-50s he mostly recorded under his own leadership, and disc 2 offers plentiful examples of his 1954 Sextet & Quartet, and the beautiful 1955 sessions with Sy Oliver's Orchestra.



**NEW! WILTON CRAWLEY - Showman, Composer and Clarinetist - Recorded in New York and Chicago 1927-1930 1 CD £12.99**

Almost all the recordings by this hot gaspipe-style clarinetist (the balance are available on BDW8025) including four unissued test pressings, one of which is not even listed in 'Rust'. 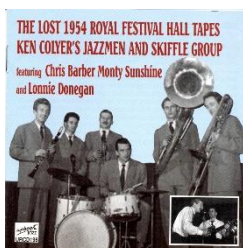
**NEW! FIRST REVOLUTION SINGERS OF NEW ORLEANS – Heaven is my Goal 504CD24 1 CD £12.99**

First formed in 1972 and reformed in 1980 this was the best a capella singing group in New Orleans, working mainly in the French Quarter. They enjoyed a residency at the Storyville Jazz Hall on Decatur Street and made numerous radio and TV appearances. They first recorded for 504 Records in 1986. Then again in 1988. This release is their complete recordings for 504.

Here are three short sessions, none of which has been previously released. The three artists need no introduction. They are legends of New Orleans music! Cousin Joe is with the Edward Frank Band recorded in the Night Shade Studio, NO in 1988. James Booker was recorded at the Memphis Hotel in 1976 and Snooks Eaglin with the Robert French Trio at Gloria's Living Room in 1967 - a popular black bar at 1801 Spain Street which became a place where musicians hung out.
